Graffiti Shield Removal Procedure





Graffiti Shield Removal Instructions:

Minimum Tools Needed:

Spray Bottle GST-0022
Dishwashing Detergent (Palmolive/Ivory/Joy)
Paper Towels (Lint Free)
6" Triumph Scraper GST-0010 (for best results)
Scrub Pad GST-0016
Orange Base Solvent Cleaner









Glass Shield and Mirror Shield Removal:

- Pull back a corner and pull the film slow and at the same angle.
- Maintain same even pull all the way until all material is removed.
- If any adhesive is left, then spray with soap water (3-4 drop dishwashing detergent per 32oz) and soak adhesive.
- Once adhesive has absorbed the soap water, then use a
 6" Triumph scraper to remove adhesive.
- Note that if your removing film off Polycarbonate or plastic windows. DO NOT USE A BLADE. Only use scrub pad. But test a small area to confirm the adhesive will remove without damaging surface.







Metal Shield and Custom Shield Removal:

- Pull back a corner and pull the film slow and at the same angle.
- Maintain same even pull all the way until all material is removed.
- If any adhesive is left, then spray with soap water (3-4 drops dishwashing detergent per 32oz) and soak adhesive.
- Once adhesive has absorbed the soap water, then use a white scrub pad and remove adhesive.
- If adhesive will not remove, then use a orange based adhesive remover with white scrub pad.
